“While living in Malawi, I started taking Sibusiso as a supplement mainly to keep my fitness level up, and to stop getting the many illnesses that are rampant in a poor country.

In March 2012, I unfortunately got very bad malaria – the less common strain of ovale malaria which unfortunately was not picked up by either the state hospital in Blantyre, nor a private hospital. The result was that I developed black water fever which progressed to a complication – adult respiratory distress syndrome. I was flown out of Malawi and arrived at St Augustine’s hospital for diagnosis and treatment (at that stage no one knew what I had). After being put in a medical coma for three days, I remained on life support for a further three or four days, and “miraculously” I recovered and was discharged.

I lost seven kg in the ten days I was in hospital and was extremely weak, and on arriving home I resumed my Sibusiso supplement. Within a few weeks I had regained most of the weight loss and more importantly my strength as measured by push-ups, sit-ups, and jogging. [Two days after discharge: 1 push-up, three sit-ups, walk about 80m. Three weeks later: 42 press-ups, 45 sit-ups, jog 2.4km]

As I had been regularly using Sibusiso in Malawi (available everywhere there at a very cheap price) and knew the benefits – kept regular illnesses at bay (particularly in a very poor country), helped me maintain a reasonable fitness level – I can honestly say that Sibusiso played no small part in my recovery from a very bad case of malaria with complications.

I attach a photo taken by my daughter when I was very close to not making it.

The attending specialists were Dr Shabir Dawood (lead) and Drs Patel (cardiologist) and Dr Grizic (urologist). I am grateful to all three, and more particularly Dr Dawood whose skill saved my life.
